Creating a New Weekend Mass Schedule

The weekend Mass schedule will change at the point when any of our priests move to senior priest status or different appointments—perhaps as early as July 2018. Please read through the information below and plan to attend one of the upcoming parishioner meetings: Mon., Apr. 9, 1:30-3:30 pm at St. Alphonsus or 7:00-9:00 pm at St. Joseph, Weedsport; Wed., Apr. 25, 1:00-3:00 pm at Sacred Heart or 6:00-8:00 pm at St. Mary's.

Who makes the decision and when?

After input from parishioners, the pastors and the rest of the planning team will make this decision at their May 1st meeting.

How will they decide?

The decision will be based upon analysis of data and prayerful discernment of what schedule best serves the needs of all Auburn-N. Cayuga area Catholics. The following principles will guide decision making:

- Enhance the participation of the faithful.
- Minimize the disruption to parishioners in their current Mass attendance patterns as much as possible given the challenge of fewer Masses.
- Pay attention to liturgical ministries, especially the existence of strong choirs or music groups. Where possible, choose vibrant music over weaker options.
- Allow the largest number of parishioners to attend Mass at more convenient, popular Mass times.
- Allow sufficient time for the priest to travel between sites for Masses, including in winter weather.
- Allow sufficient time for the priest to prepare for Mass and to interact with parishioners afterward.
- The Mass schedule may affect the times for Sunday morning faith formation sessions, but families will be able to participate in both Mass and religious education.
- Pay attention to the potential impact on the Offertory. Anticipate that Mass attendance may decline at least initially. Consider how that will affect the Offertory.

What options are being considered?

The planning team has agreed to present the following options to parishioners for feedback. The final Mass schedule will depend on the input received. You will notice that none of these options anticipates having a weekend Mass at St. John in Port Byron. **The new schedule will include a Sunday 5:00 pm regional Mass.**
